The Neonatal Withdrawal and Rehabilitation Program is a specialty health care resource for infants suffering from Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome.

Our hospital specializes in providing a broad range of complex medical and rehabilitative care, with a comprehensive approach that is unmatched.

The Neonatal Abstinence Program is part of our nationally recognized Infant Toddler Program.

Renown for providing a variety of comprehensive rehabilitations for infants and young children from birth to 2 years of age, our program serves young patients who require all levels of pediatric care.

Through a series of remarkable new programs and therapies, we help children continue to play, learn and grow while reclaiming their lives.

Patient-and-Family Centered Care:

In our environment of patient-and-family centered care, we recognize the vital role that families play in ensuring the health and well-being of children. Our goal is to empower children and families to discover their own strength, build confidence and make health care choices and decisions in partnership with our staff.

Our Specialized Care:

- Development Assessment by Psychology

- Comprehensive Caregiver Training utilizing bedside DVD videos and hands on approach to infant care
